



Use of ASCA National Model,[®] RAMP[®] and School Counselor of the Year[®] Terminology

External Trademark and Attribution Policy

The American School Counselor Association (ASCA) protects its intellectual property to ensure clarity, accuracy and trust for school counselors, schools and partners. This policy explains how outside organizations may reference the ASCA National Model[®] and the Recognized ASCA Model Program[®] (RAMP[®]). This policy applies to all non-ASCA entities, including but not limited to vendors, consultants, publishers, districts, state associations, researchers and nonprofit or for-profit organizations.

Trademark ownership

- **ASCA National Model[®]** is a registered trademark of the American School Counselor Association.
- The **ASCA National Model[®] diagram** (diamond graphic) is a registered trademark and may not be reprinted or modified without written permission from ASCA.
- **Recognized ASCA Model Program[®] (RAMP[®])** is a registered trademark of ASCA.
- **School Counselor of the Year[®]** and associated logos and designs.

Permitted use without written permission

Outside organizations may reference the ASCA National Model[®] or RAMP[®] in text only when all of the following conditions are met:

- The full trademarked name is used on first reference:
 - ASCA National Model[®]
 - Recognized ASCA Model Program[®] (RAMP[®])
 - School Counselor of the Year[®]
- The ® symbol appears on first reference in each standalone publication, webpage or presentation.
- The reference is descriptive and factual, such as noting alignment or relevance.
- The use does not imply endorsement, approval, certification or partnership by ASCA.
- A required disclaimer is included (see below).

Prohibited use without written permission

Outside organizations may **not**:

- Use ASCA trademarks in:
 - Product names
 - Program titles
 - Company or organization names
 - Taglines or slogans
- Use, reproduce, adapt or modify:

- The ASCA National Model[®] diagram
- RAMP[®] logos or graphics
- School Counselor of the Year[®] logos, seals or designs
- Create derivative or look-alike graphics.
- Modify trademarks or combine them with other branding.
- State or imply ASCA endorsement, approval or sponsorship.
- Refer to individuals as “RAMP school counselors.” RAMP[®] is a school designation, not an individual credential.
- Use “School Counselor of the Year[®]” in a way that suggests an ongoing title, certification or endorsement beyond the year awarded. State school counselor associations must always use the state name when referencing their state School Counselor of the Year[®].

Required disclaimer language

One of the following disclaimers must appear wherever the ASCA National Model[®], RAMP[®] or School Counselor of the Year[®] are referenced.

Standard disclaimer

ASCA National Model,[®] Recognized ASCA Model Program[®] (RAMP[®]) and School Counselor of the Year[®] are registered trademarks of the American School Counselor Association. Use of these terms does not imply endorsement by ASCA.

Expanded disclaimer (recommended for marketing, training or paid products)

ASCA National Model,[®] Recognized ASCA Model Program[®] (RAMP[®]) and School Counselor of the Year[®] are registered trademarks of the American School Counselor Association. This product or service is not affiliated with, endorsed by or approved by ASCA.

Placement of disclaimers

Disclaimers should appear clearly and legibly:

- On the same page as the first trademark reference
- In a footer or acknowledgements section
- On slides or handouts that reference ASCA National Model,[®] RAMP[®] School Counselor of the Year[®]
- On marketing or sales webpages that reference alignment

Requests for permission
