HOW TO MARTA

A fast and affordable way to navigate the city, MARTA provides approximately 500,000 passenger trips each weekday in Atlanta. Purchase a re-loadable Breeze Card (\$2) and add the desired fare amount (\$2.50 per single ride). Breeze tickets also are available for a \$1 surcharge plus the \$2.50 fare for a single ride. Breeze Cards and tickets can be purchased at Breeze vending machines located in rail stations or MARTA Ride Stores. You can also order the MARTA Visitor Pass in advance.

ATLANTA STREETCAR

The Atlanta Streetcar is Atlanta's newest transportation option. The 2.7 mile loop has 12 stops that connect Centennial Olympic Park with the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historical Park and nearby neighborhoods east of downtown. With a direct connection to MARTA's Peachtree Center station, and other transit services, the Atlanta Streetcar provides the last mile of connectivity to the city's public transportation system. Tips for Taxi Use

If paying by credit card, verify the taxi can accept this form of payment before entering the vehicle. Please note, many Atlanta taxi drivers are independent operators and do not have the ability to accept credit cards

It IS permissible to hail a cab from the curb/street.

Understanding Zone Fare vs Metered Fare- Atlanta is unique from most cities, in that the most heavily trafficked areas are set on flat rate zone fares.

Always make note of the company name and taxi number of the cab you are using

RENTAL CARS

Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport

If you choose to rent a car in Atlanta, our rental car center makes it easy once you've arrived at Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport. The ATL SkyTrain is an elevated train that connects the passenger terminal to the rental car center, and takes customers on a scenic, five-minute ride to the rental car center to sign rental agency contracts and pick up cars.

UBER/LYFT

Uber and Lyft connect riders in Atlanta with drivers via their mobile apps, which you can download for free today.

For Atlanta Airport: all rideshare drivers will pick up passengers at the North and South economy lots, which are a short walk from baggage claim. Passengers will proceed through baggage claim toward the Georgia Lottery booth for access to the lower-level escalators. Once downstairs, follow the orange signs to the Economy lot and request a ride only after arrival at the pick-up location.

OTHER WAYS TO GET AROUND ATLANTA

ROADWAYS

Atlanta is accessible via Interstates 20, 75, and 85 and Georgia 400. I-285 forms a beltway around the city.

The **ParkMobile App** makes it quick and convenient to find and pay for parking all over Atlanta. ParkMobile can be used to pay for parking at any on-street parking spot in the city and in many off-street lots. Just look for the bright green signs that will provide information on how to pay using the app. ParkMobile can also be used to make parking reservations in advance at the Georgia World Congress Center, State Farm Arena, Mercedes-Benz Stadium, and more. THE BUC

The Buckhead Uptown Connection (The Buc) provides free service throughout the Buckhead business district. Stops include the Lenox and Buckhead MARTA stations, Lenox Square and Phipps Plaza, various restaurants and hotels and numerous office buildings.

SCOOTERS

Last-Mile Mobility options such as Relay Bike and scooters (such as BIRD, Lime and Uber) are located in various areas of the city. Simply download an app, locate the transportation mode and unlock it from the app.



If you need help finding where to go or what to do in Downtown Atlanta, you won't have to look hard to find one of the 67 members of our friendly and helpful Ambassador Force. They're the ones in the pith helmets and sometimes, they can be seen riding Segway human transporters or all-terrain bikes.

The Ambassador Force of the Downtown Improvement District will provide a walking escort for employees and residents in the District to a parking lot, MARTA station or any location in the District during the following hours:

Monday - Sunday from 7:00am to Midnight
